DECREE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE SPECIAL CAPITAL REGION OF JAKARTA

NUMBER 19 OF 2021

REGARDING

THE ENFORCEMENT, PERIOD, AND OUT-OF-HOME ACTIVITIES RESTRICTIONS  
OF LARGE-SCALE SOCIAL RESTRICTIONS

WITH THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

GOVERNOR OF SPECIAL CAPITAL REGION OF JAKARTA,

Considering : whereas to implement the provision of Article 35 paragraph (5) of Governor Regulation Number 3 of 2021 regarding Implementation Regulation of Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding Covid-19 Management, it is necessary to stipulate a Governor Decree regarding the Enforcement, Period, and Out-of-Home Activities Restrictions of Large-Scale Social Restrictions;

Bearing in Mind : 1. Law Number 29 of 2007 regarding the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Provincial Government as the Capital of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2007 Number 93, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4744);

2. Law Number 23 of 2014 regarding Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 5587) as amended several times, the latest by Law Number 9 of 2015 regarding Second Amendment to Law

HAS DECIDED:

- To Stipulate : GOVERNOR DECREE REGARDING THE ENFORCEMENT, PERIOD, AND OUT-OF-HOME ACTIVITIES RESTRICTIONS OF LARGE-SCALE SOCIAL RESTRICTIONS.
- FIRST : To stipulate the Enforcement, Period, and Out-of-Home Activities Restrictions of Large-Scale Social Restrictions from January 11, 2021, to January 25, 2021.
- SECOND : During the Large-Scale Social Restrictions period as referred to in the FIRST dictum, Large-Scale Social Restrictions out-of-home activities restrictions will be enforced by implementing the COVID-19 prevention protocol in accordance with Governor Regulation Number 3 of 2021 concerning Implementation Regulation of Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding Management of the Corona Virus Disease 2019.
- THIRD : The types of restrictions on out-of-home activities as referred to in the SECOND dictum are listed in the Appendix which is an inseparable part of this Governor Decree.
- FOURTH : When this Governor Decree comes into effect, the Governor Decree Number 1295 of 2020 regarding Extension of the Enforcement of Large-Scale Social Restrictions during the Transition Period to a Healthy, Safe, and Productive Society shall be revoked and declared invalid.

FIFTH : This Governor Decree shall come into force on the date of its stipulation.
