Following the issuance of Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Number 8 of 2021 dated February 9, 2021 regarding Health Protocols for International Travels During the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Pandemic, it is hereby conveyed as follows:

1. Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Number 8 of 2021 states that the provision on the travelling traffic of foreigners to enter the territory of Indonesia is based on the Minister of Law and Human Rights Regulation No. 26 of 2020 regarding Visa and Stay Permit during the Adaptation Period During the New Normal Adaptation Period as contained in letter F number 2 (a);
2. The administrative requirements and exceptions for foreigners who may enter the Indonesian Territory are:
 - a. Administrative requirements for the application of eVisa:
 - 1) RT-PCR result is not required;
 - 2) foreigners must provide a statement letter of willingness to independently pay for their medical treatment expenses if they are exposed to COVID-19 while in Indonesia.
 - b. Exceptions for the limitation of foreigners who may enter the territory of Indonesia:
 - 1) KITAS and KITAP holder which are still valid;
 - 2) Foreigners who had owned eVisa;
 - 3) Supporting personnel and aid of medical, foodstuff and humanitarian reasons;
 - 4) Conveyance crew; and

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- 5) Foreigners who will work in strategic vital project, national vital object, national strategic project.
The provisions of point 3, point 4 and point 5 may be granted based on the recommendation from the relevant ministry/technical institution;
3. Foreigners who had extended their Visit Stay Permit for 4 (four) times and do not exceed 180 (one hundred and eighty) days and holders of a Limited Stay Permit who cannot extend their Stay Permit in accordance with the laws and regulations must apply for a new Stay Permit by applying for an onshore Visa;
4. The application for onshore Visa shall be conducted before the Stay Permit expires;
5. The validity period of the new Stay Permit which is derived from the onshore Visa shall be counted pursuant to the date of the onshore Visa approval, without counting the expiry date of the previous Stay Permit, with the approval of the onshore Visa as the overstay period (exceeding the time limit of the Stay Permit);
6. With this affirmation letter being in force, thus circular letter number IMI-GR.01.01-0210 dated January 26, 2021 regarding Affirmation and Extension on the Enforcement Period of Circular Letter of the Director General of Immigration Number IMI-0103.GR.01.01 of 2021 is declared to remain in force.
7. In certain circumstances, the Minister based on its authority may issue another policy related to immigration facility in so far as it gives public benefit and national economic recovery;
