

HEAD OF COVID-19 HANDLING TASK FORCE DECREE NUMBER 9 OF 2021 REGARDING

LOCATION OF QUARANTINE, ISOLATION, AND RT-PCR OBLIGATION FOR INDONESIAN CITIZENS AS INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS

Considering:

a.

- whereas to implement provisions of the *Addendum* of Head of Covid-19 Handling Task Force Circular Letter Number 3 of 2020 and Head of Covid-19 Handling Task Force Circular Letter Number 4 of 2020, regarding Indonesian citizens as international travelers during the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) Pandemic that has been implemented through the Head of Covid-19 Handling Task Force Decree Number 6 of 2021 regarding Hotel Criteria and RT-PCR Obligation for Indonesian Citizens as International Travelers;
- b. whereas the Decree as referred to in letter a is no longer appropriate with the requirements of COVID-19 handling, hence must be revoked and replaced anew;
- c. whereas based on the considerations as referred to in letter a and b, it is necessary to stipulate Head of Covid-19 Handling Task Force Decree regarding Location of Quarantine, Isolation, and RT-PCR Obligations for Indonesian Citizens as International Travelers.

HAS DECIDED:

To Stipulate : HEAD OF COVID-19 HANDLING TASK FORCE DECREE

REGARDING LOCATION OF QUARANTINE, ISOLATION, AND RT-PCR OBLIGATIONS FOR INDONESIAN CITIZENS AS

INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS

FIRST : To stipulate the isolation/quarantine location for Indonesian Citizens

as International Travelers in Wisma Pamedangan in which its services consists of lodging, transportation, meals, and security.

SECOND : If the Wisma Pamedangan lodging as referred to in the FIRST

Dictum is full, isolation/quarantine location shall be conducted in a selected 2 (two) star hotel and 3 (three) star hotel with services

equivalent to Wisma Pamedangan.

THIRD : Funding for isolation/quarantine location and RT-PCR test are

sourced from Ready to Use Fund (*Dana Siap Pakai or DSP*) of the National Body of Disaster Management and must only be allocated for Indonesian Citizens as International Travelers by fulfilling the

following criteria:



- a. Indonesian Migrant Workers (*Pekerja Migran Indonesia* or PMI) returning to stay in Indonesia for at least 14 days;
- b. Students/University Students returning to Indonesia after conducting studies or education duties overseas; or
- c. Government Employees returning to Indonesia after conducting official overseas travel with state's funding.

FOURTH

Mechanism of the isolation/quarantine location payment shall be conducted by the Commitment Formation Official (*Pejabat Pembuat Komitmen* or PPK) that is appointed by the Budget User Authority (*Kuasa Pengguna Anggaran* or KPA) of the National Board of Disaster Management (*Badan Nasional Penaggulangan Bencana* or BNPN) in accordance with laws and regulation and after passing the verification/review process by the Supervisory Body of Finance and Development (*Bada Pengawasan Keamanan dan Pembangunan* or BPKP)

FIFTH

This Decree revokes the Head of Covid-19 Handling Task Force Decree Number 6 of 2021 regarding Hotel Criteria and RT-PCR Obligation for Indonesian Citizens as International Travelers.

SIXTH

This Decree shall come into force on February 9, 2021 provided that if an error is contained in the future, correction will be conducted accordingly.
