

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**ICCC Joins 21-Market Indo-Pacific Alliance to Strengthen Canada–Indonesia Trade Corridor**

New regional platform connects Indonesian businesses to a coordinated Indo-Pacific network

(Jakarta, April 16, 2026) The Indonesia Canada Chamber of Commerce (ICCC) has joined a 21-market Indo-Pacific business alliance, strengthening its role in linking Indonesian businesses with Canadian and regional trade and investment opportunities. The agreement, signed on April 16 and witnessed by Prime Minister of Canada Mark Carney, marks the first time Canadian chambers across the Indo-Pacific have aligned under a single platform.

For ICCC, the move signals a shift toward a more coordinated regional approach—at a time when competition for investment and supply chain positioning across Southeast Asia is intensifying.

Said ICCC Chair Vivien Kusumowardhani, “Indonesia has long been part of Canada’s Indo-Pacific strategy, and through the signing of this MOU, we can more actively shape trade and investment conversations across the region.”

Indonesia remains one of Southeast Asia’s largest and fastest-growing economies and joining the alliance is another key initiative the ICCC is taking to engage in its core mission which is to:

- Strengthen Indonesia’s visibility within Canadian trade and investment networks
- Facilitate more targeted trade missions and partnerships into Indonesia
- Provide Canadian businesses with clearer entry points into the Indonesian market
- Enable ICCC members, both Indonesian and Canadian, to access a broader Indo-Pacific business network

Added Vivien Kusumowardhani, “The timing of ICCC joining the alliance is critical as global companies are increasingly looking to diversify supply chains and deepen their presence in Southeast Asia, with Indonesia emerging as a priority market. The CCIP network provides ICCC members with more opportunities to collaborate directly with counterparts in key markets in the Indo-Pacific region to create opportunities for cross-border initiatives and shared market intelligence.”

To strengthen Indonesia’s position within broader regional trade discussions, ICCC will participate in upcoming CCIP initiatives, including:

- Joint trade missions across ASEAN and Canada
- Regional policy dialogues with government stakeholders
- Sector-focused collaborations in areas such as energy, infrastructure, and digital trade
