**ENFORCEMENT, STAGES, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF LARGE-SCALE SOCIAL
RESTRICTION ACTIVITIES DURING THE TRANSITIONAL PERIOD TO A HEALTHY,
SAFE, AND PRODUCTIVE SOCIETY**

WITH THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

GOVERNOR OF SPECIAL CAPITAL CITY REGION OF JAKARTA,

- Considering** : Whereas to implement the provisions of Article 4 paragraph (4) of Governor Regulation Number 51 of 2020 regarding Implementation of Large-Scale Social Restrictions during the Transitional Period to a Clean, Safe, and Productive Society, it is necessary to stipulate Governor Decree regarding the Enforcement, Stages, and Implementation of Large-Scale Social Restrictions Activities During the Transitional Period to a Healthy, Safe, and Productive Society;
- Bearing in Mind** : 1. Law Number 29 of 2007 regarding the Special Capital City Region of Jakarta Provincial Government as the Capital City of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2007 Number 93, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4744);

2. Law Number 23 of 2014 regarding Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5589) as amended several times, lastly by Law Number 9 of 2015 regarding the Second Amendment to Law Number 23 of 2014 regarding Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 Number 58, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5679);

HAS DECIDED:

- To Stipulate : GOVERNOR DECREE REGARDING THE ENFORCEMENT, STAGES, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF LARGE-SCALE SOCIAL RESTRICTION ACTIVITIES DURING THE TRANSITIONAL PERIOD TO A HEALTHY, SAFE, AND PRODUCTIVE SOCIETY
- FIRST : To stipulate the enforcement Large-Scale Social Restrictions during the transitional period for a healthy, safe, and productive society for 14 (fourteen) days since June 5, 2020 until June 18, 2020 with the types of activities that may be carried out as stated in Appendix I which is an integral part of this Governor Decree.
- SECOND : If there is no significant increase of new COVID-19 cases during the enforcement of Large-Scale Social Restrictions during the transitional period as referred to in the FIRST dictum, based on the results of the monitoring and evaluation by the Provincial level Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19 it shall be stipulated that the enforcement of Large-Scale Social Restrictions during the transitional period to a healthy, safe and productive society for the next 14 (fourteen) days as of June 19, 2020 until July 2, 2020 with types of activities that may be carried out during the transitional period as stipulated in Appendix II which is an integral part of this Governor Decree.

- THIRD : The transitional period as mentioned in the FIRST and/or SECOND dictum may be stopped if there is significant increase of new cases based on the results of the monitoring and evaluation result by the Provincial level Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19.
- FOURTH : This Governor Decree enters into force on the date of its stipulation.
