**AMENDMENT TO CIRCULAR LETTER NUMBER 7 OF 2020 REGARDING CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRAVELING OF PEOPLE IN THE PERIOD OF ADAPTATION OF NEW NORMAL TOWARDS A PRODUCTIVE AND CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)-SAFE SOCIETY**

**A. Background**

The substance of the Background in Circular Letter Number of 7 of 2020 regarding Criteria and Requirements for the Traveling of People in the Period of Adaptation of New Normal Towards a Productive and Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)-Safe Society has not changed.

**B. Objectives and Purpose**

## E. Definition

The substance of the Definition in Circular Letter Number of 7 of 2020 regarding Criteria and Requirements for the Traveling of People in the Period of Adaptation of New Normal Towards a Productive and Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)-Safe Society has not changed.

## F. Criteria and Requirements

The Criteria and Requirements in Circular Letter Number of 7 of 2020 regarding Criteria and Requirements for the Traveling of People in the Period of Adaptation of New Normal Towards a Productive and Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)-Safe Society is amended to read:

1. Every individual who travels is required to implement and adhere to health protocols namely wearing masks, maintaining distance, and washing hands as criteria of the traveling of people.
2. The requirements for domestic traveling of people:
  - a. Every individual who travels with a personal vehicle is responsible for their own health, and is subject to and complies with the applicable terms and conditions;
  - b. Every individual who travels by public land, railway, sea, and air transportation must meet the following the requirements:
    - 1) Present a personal identification (*Kartu Tanda Penduduk/KTP* or other valid identification document);
    - 2) Present a statement letter of PCR test with negative result or a statement letter of Rapid Test with a non-reactive result that is valid for 14 days at the time of departure;
    - 3) Present a statement letter of the absence of symptoms of influenza-like illness issued by a Hospital/Community Health Center (*Puskesmas*) Doctor for regions that do not have PCR Test and/or Rapid-Test facilities.
  - c. The requirements for domestic traveling of people are exempted for the traveling of commuters and the traveling of people within an agglomeration territory/region.
  - d. Download and activate *Peduli Lindungi* application on their mobile device.

3. The requirements for traveling of people arriving from abroad:
  - a. Every individual arriving from abroad must obey and comply with the applicable terms and conditions:

- 1) Every individual arriving from abroad must undergo a PCR Test upon arrival, if that person has not undergone one and is unable to present a PCR Test result letter from the country of departure;
  - 2) PCR Test examination for the traveling of people is excluded for Cross-Border Post (*Pos Lintas Batas Negara/PLBN*) that do not have PCR equipment, by conducting a rapid test and presenting a statement letter of the absence of symptoms of influenza-like illness, and are exempt for traveling of commuters who go through PLBN by presenting a statement letter of the absence of symptoms of influenza-like illness issued by a Hospital Doctor/Health authority.
- b. During the PCR test result waiting period, every individual must undergo quarantine at a special quarantine accommodation provided by the government; or
  - c. Utilizing the quarantine accommodation (Hotel/Lodging) that has received certification of COVID-19 accommodation from the Ministry of Health;
  - d. Download and activate *Peduli Lindungi* application on their mobile device.

This Circular letter is effective as of the date of its stipulation, and can be amended in accordance with the development of the situation, and shall end upon the stipulation of a Presidential Decree terminating Presidential Decree Number 11 of 2020 regarding Stipulation of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a Public Health Emergency.
