**CIRCULAR LETTER**  
NUMBER 2021 OF 2020

**REGARDING**

**IMPLEMENTATION OF PUBLIC ACTIVITIES DURING THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS AND WELCOMING THE 2021 NEW YEAR IN THE NEW NORMAL ERA IN THE PROVINCE OF BALI**

**Based on:**

1. Governor of Bali Regulation Number 46 of 2020 regarding Discipline and Law Enforcement of Health Protocols as an Effort to Prevent and Control the Corona Virus Disease 2019 in the New Normal Era; and
2. Governor of Bali Circular Letter Number 3355 of 2020 regarding the New Normal Era Protocol.

**Considering:**

1. The high rate of transmission of positive Covid-19 cases in Indonesia, including Bali Province marked by the emergence of new clusters;
2. The increased flow of visits to Bali and high potential for crowd gatherings during the Christmas holidays and welcoming the 2021 New Year in Bali Province;
3. The need for all parties to maintain health, comfort, security, and safety, as well as a positive image of Bali as a world tourist destination; and
4. Direction of the Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment of the Republic of Indonesia at a virtual meeting on December 14, 2020.

To effectuate Governor of Bali Circular Letter regarding Implementation of Public Activities During the Christmas Holidays and Welcoming the 2021 New Year in a New Normal Era in the Province of Bali as follows:

1. To truly, orderly, and with discipline as well as with full responsibility comply with provisions of the following:
  - a. Governor of Bali Regulation Number 46 of 2020 regarding Discipline and Law Enforcement of Health Protocols as an Effort to Prevent and Control the Corona Virus Disease 2019 in a New Normal Era; and
  - b. Governor of Bali Circular Letter Number 3355 of 2020 regarding the New Normal Era Protocols.
2. Domestic Travelers (PPDN) who **will enter the region of Bali** must comply with the following provisions:
  - a. responsible for their own health, as well as complying to and obeying the applicable terms and conditions;
  - b. for those traveling by air transportation, it is required to show a certificate of **negative result of PCR-based swab test** with a maximum validity of 2 x 24 hours before departure, and to fill out the Indonesian *e-HAC*;
  - c. for those who travel using private vehicles via land and sea transportation are required to show a **negative result of the Rapid Test Antigen test** with a validity of no later than 2 x 24 hours before departure.
  - d. certificate of negative result of PCR-based swab test and negative result of Rapid Test Antigen test **valid for 14 (fourteen) days** as of issuance
  - e. while still in Bali, it is required to have a certificate of a negative result of a PCR-based swab test or a negative result of a valid Rapid Test Antigen test.
  - f. for PPDN departing from Bali, a PCR-based or Rapid Test Antigen-based swab test result certificate that is still valid **can be used** for the return trip to Bali.

3. All Business Actors, Managers, Operators or Persons in Charge of Public Places and Facilities that carry out activities during the Christmas Holidays and welcoming the 2021 New Year are:
  - a. required to implement health protocols namely:
    - 1) wearing masks properly;
    - 2) washing hands with soap with running water or with hand sanitizer;
    - 3) limiting physical interaction and always maintaining distance;
    - 4) not forming crowds; and
    - 5) limiting activities in public places/crowds.
  - b. strictly prohibited to:
    - 1) hold new year celebration parties and the like indoors and/or outdoors;
    - 2) use firecrackers, fireworks, and the like; and
    - 3) be intoxicated with liquor.
4. All Business Actors, Managers, Operators or Persons in Charge of Public Places and Facilities that violate the provisions as referred to in number 2 and number 3 shall be subject to sanctions in accordance with Governor of Bali Regulation Number 46 of 2020 and other Laws and Regulations.
5. To Regents/Mayors, Heads of District, Village Heads/Heads of Sub-District, Customary *Bandesa* in Bali, as well as related parties must coordinate, communicate and socialize this Circular to be implemented in an orderly, disciplined and fully responsible manner.
6. The Commander of the IX Regional Military Command/Udayana and the Chief of Bali Regional Police are requested to carry out disciplinary enforcement operations to ensure the implementation of this Circular.
7. This Circular enters into force from December 18, 2020 up to January 4, 2021.

Thus this Circular is conveyed to be implemented with discipline and full responsibility. Thank you for your cooperation.
