REGARDING

**IMPLEMENTATION OF CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 EMERGENCY
RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC ACTIVITIES**

WITH THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

GOVERNOR OF SPECIAL CAPITAL REGION OF JAKARTA,

- Considering : a. whereas to follow up the Instructions of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 15 of 2021 regarding the Implementation of Corona Virus Disease 2019 Emergency Restrictions on Public Activities (*Pemberlakuan Pembatasan Kegiatan Masyarakat – “PPKM”*) in Java and Bali, it is required to stipulate Governor Decree regarding the Implementation of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Emergency Restrictions on Public Activities;
- Bearing in Mind : 1. Law Number 29 of 2007 regarding the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Provincial Government as the Capital of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2007 Number 93, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4744);

2. Law Number 23 of 2014 regarding Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5587) as amended several times, the latest by Law Number 11 of 2020 regarding Job Creation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2020 Number 245, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6573);
3. Law Number 30 of 2014 regarding Government Administration (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 292, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5601) as amended by Law Number 11 of 2020 regarding Job Creation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2020 Number 245, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6573);
4. Law Number 6 of 2018 regarding Health Quarantine (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2018 Number 128, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6236);
5. Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding the Management of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Regional Gazette of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province of 2020 Number 201, Supplement to the Regional Gazette of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province Number 2008);
6. Governor Regulation Number 3 of 2021 regarding Implementing Regulation of the Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding Management of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Regional Gazette of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province of 2021 Number 62002);

HAS DECIDED:

- To Stipulate : GOVERNOR DECREE REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 EMERGENCY RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC ACTIVITIES
- FIRST : To stipulate the Implementation of Corona Virus Disease 2019 Emergency Restrictions on Public Activities for 18 (eighteen) days from July 3, 2021, until July 20, 2021.
- SECOND : The implementation of Covid-19 health protocols and the enforcement of its sanctions in this Governor Decree shall be done in accordance with the provisions in Governor Regulation Number 3 of 2021 regarding the Implementing Regulation of Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding the Management of the Corona Virus Disease 2019.
- THIRD : Types of Corona Virus Disease 2019 Emergency Restrictions on Public Activities as referred to in the FIRST dictum shall be listed in the Appendix which shall be an integral part of this Governor Decree.
- FOURTH : As this Governor Decree comes into effect, Governor Decree Number 796 of 2021 regarding the Extension of the Implementation of Micro-Based Restrictions on Public Activities is revoked and shall be declared invalid.
- FIFTH : This Governor Decree shall enter into force on July 3, 2021.
