# THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LEVEL 3 CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 RESTRICTIONS FOR COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

#### WITH THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

GOVERNOR OF SPECIAL CAPITAL CITY REGION OF JAKARTA,

#### Considering

: whereas to follow up the Instructions of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 43 of 2021 regarding the Implementation of Level 4, Level 3, and Level 2 Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions for Community Activities in Java and Bali, it is necessary to stipulate a Governor Decree regarding the Implementation of Level 3 Corona Virus Disease 2019 for Community Activities;

#### Bearing in Mind

To Stipulate : GOVERNOR DECREE REGARDING THE

IMPLEMENTATION OF LEVEL 3 CORONA VIRUS DISEASE

2019 RESTRICTIONS FOR COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES.

FIRST : To stipulate the enactment of the Implementation of Level 3

Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions for Community Activities for 14 (fourteen) days since September 21, 2021 until

October 4, 2021.

SECOND : The implementation of the Covid-19 Health Protocol and the

enforcement of sanctions in this Governor Decree is carried out in accordance with the provisions in Governor Regulation Number 3 of 2021 Implementing Regulation of the Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding Management of the

Corona Virus Disease 2019.

THIRD : Types of enactment of the Implementation of Level 3 Corona

Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions for Community Activities as referred to in the FIRST dictum shall be listed in the Attachment

which shall be an integral part of this Governor Decree.

FOURTH : During the Implementation of Level 3 Corona Virus Disease

2019 Restrictions on Public Activities, every person carrying out activities in each sector/place must have been vaccinated for Covid-19 (at least the first dose of vaccination) except for people who are still within the grace period of 3 (three) months after being infected by Covid-19 as evidenced by laboratory results, people who are contraindicated for Covid-19 vaccination based on the results of a medical examination with evidenced by a medical certificate, and children aged less than

12 (twelve) years.

FIFTH : People who have been vaccinated is proven by the status of

having been vaccinated on the Jakarta Kini (JAKI) application, vaccination certificates in Peduli Lindungi and/or proof of

vaccinations issued by authorized institutions.

SIXTH : This Governor Decree shall enter into force on September 21,

2021.
