NUMBER 59 OF 2022

REGARDING

**THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LEVEL 2 CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 RESTRICTIONS
ON PUBLIC ACTIVITIES**

Considering : that in order to follow up the Instruction of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 05 of 2022 for the Implementation of Level 3, Level 2, and Level 1 Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions on Public Activities in the Java and Bali Regions, it is necessary to stipulate a Governor's Decree regarding the Implementation of Level 2 Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions on Public Activities;

In view of :

1. Law Number 29 of 2007 regarding the Provincial Government of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta as the Capital of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2007 Number 93, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4744);
2. Law Number 23 of 2014 regarding Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5587) as amended several times and lastly amended by Law Number 11 of 2020 regarding Job Creation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2020 Number 245, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6573);
3. Law Number 30 of 2014 regarding Government Administration (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 292, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5601) as amended by Law

Number 11 of 2020 regarding Job Creation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2020 Number 245, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6573);

4. Law Number 6 of 2018 regarding Health Quarantine (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2018 Number 128, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6236);
5. Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding the Prevention of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Provincial Gazette of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta of 2020 Number 201, Supplement to the Regional Gazette of the Province of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Number 2008);
6. Governor's Regulation Number 3 of 2021 regarding Implementing Regulations of Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding Handling of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Regional Gazette of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta of 2021 Number 62002);

HAS DECIDED:

- To Stipulate : DECISION OF THE GOVERNOR REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LEVEL 2 CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 RESTRICTION ON COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES.
- FIRST : To stipulate the implementation of Level 2 Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions on Public Activities for 7 (seven) days from January 25, 2022 to January 31, 2022.
- SECOND : The type of implementation of Level 2 Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions on Public Activities as referred to in the FIRST dictum is listed in the Appendix which is an integral part of this Governor's Decree.
- THIRD : During the implementation of Level 2 Corona Virus Disease 2019 Restrictions on Public Activities, everyone who carries out

activities in each sector/place must have been vaccinated against Covid-19 (at least the first dose of vaccination) except for residents who are still within a grace period of 3 (three) months after being confirmed with Covid-19 as evidenced by laboratory results, residents who have contraindications and are vaccinated against Covid-19 based on the results of a medical examination with evidence of a doctor's certificate and children aged less than 12 (twelve) years.

- FOURTH : Everyone who has been vaccinated as referred to in the THIRD dictum is proven by proof of status having been vaccinated on the Jakarta Kini (JAKI) application, *PeduliLindung* application and/or proof of vaccination issued by authorized institutions.
- FIVE : To optimize the use and enforcement of the *PeduliLindung* application, the managers/persons in charge of offices, shopping centers, malls, trade centers, restaurants, sports facilities and tourist attractions will carry out screening on all visitors and employees using the Jakarta Kini (JAKI) application, the *PeduliLindung* application and/or proof of vaccination issued by the competent authority.
- SIX : The implementation of the Covid-19 health protocols and enforcement of the use of the *PeduliLindung* application in this Governor's Decree is carried out in accordance with the Governor's Regulation Number 3 of 2021 regarding Implementing Regulations of Regional Regulation Number 2 of 2020 regarding the Prevention of Corona Virus Disease 2019.
- SEVEN : This Governor's Decree comes into force on January 25, 2022.
